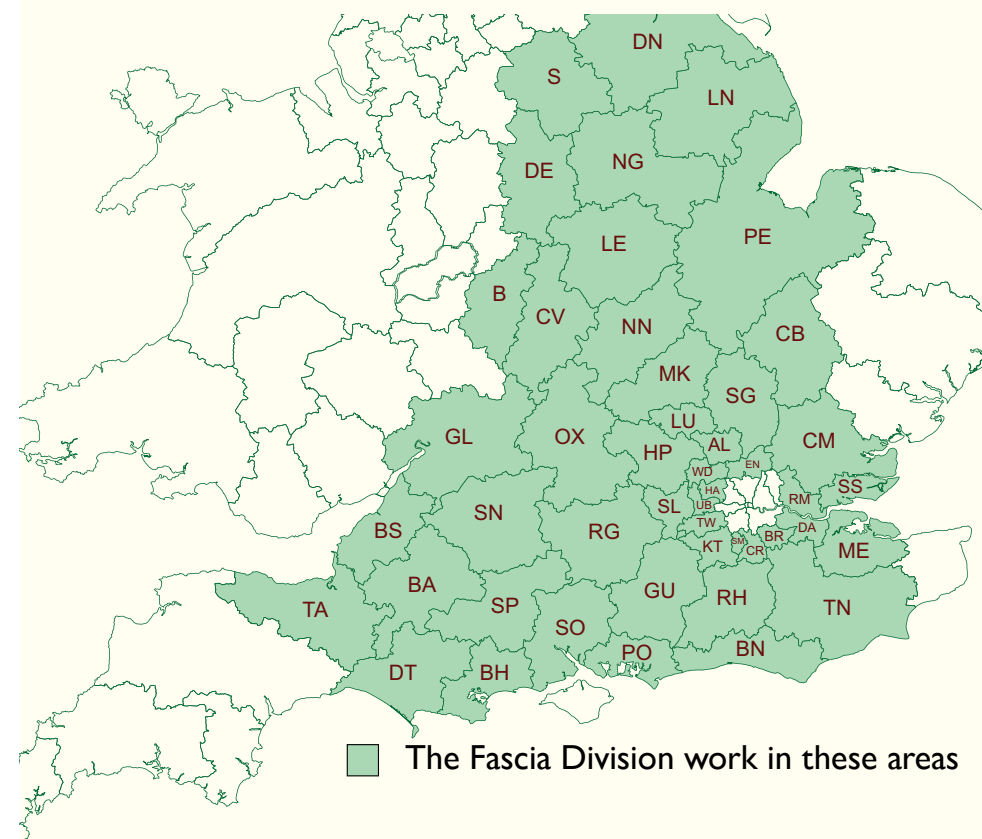

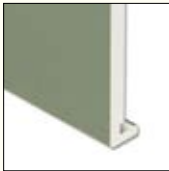

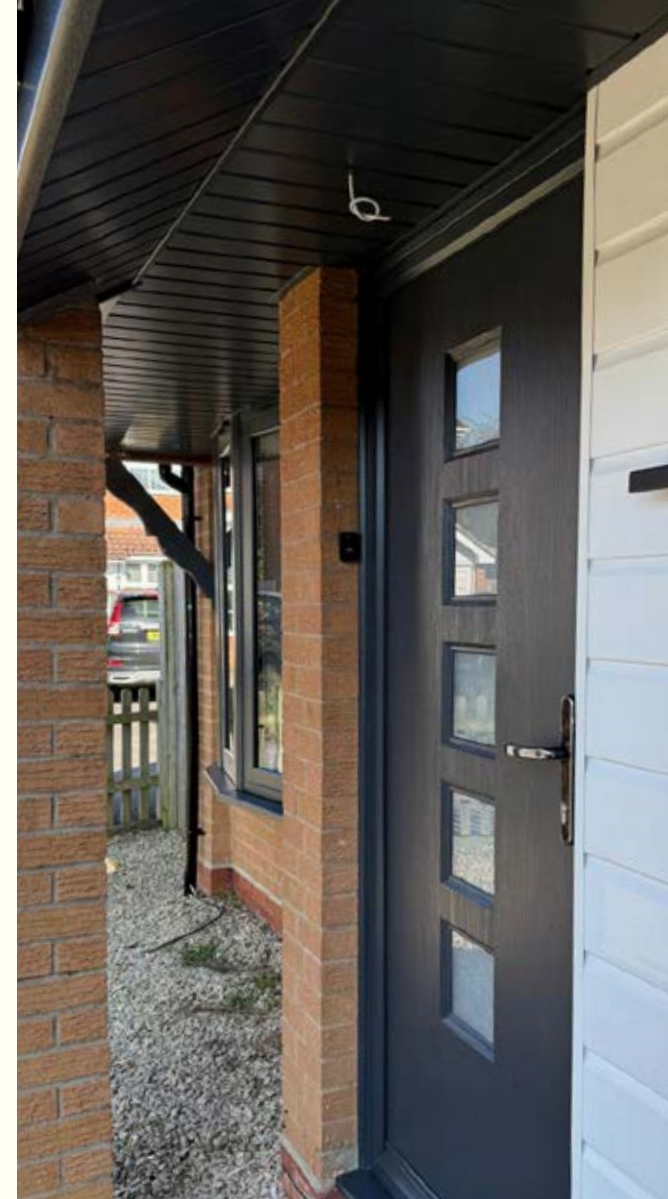
Full roofline and window replacement with anthracite fascias, soffits, guttering, and Rockdoor front door — Berkshire

This property originally featured timber fascias and soffits with peeling brown paint and tired white uPVC windows that had lost their appeal. The existing brown PVC guttering was also outdated and showing signs of wear.

Our team carried out a full exterior upgrade, removing all the old wooden roofline components and installing anthracite grey uPVC fascia boards, matching soffits, and black guttering for a clean, modern contrast.

We also replaced every window with anthracite grey uPVC flush frames and fitted a brand-new Rockdoor front door to complete the transformation.

The result is a dramatic before-and-after change — the property now looks like a contemporary new build, perfectly colour-coordinated from roofline to door.

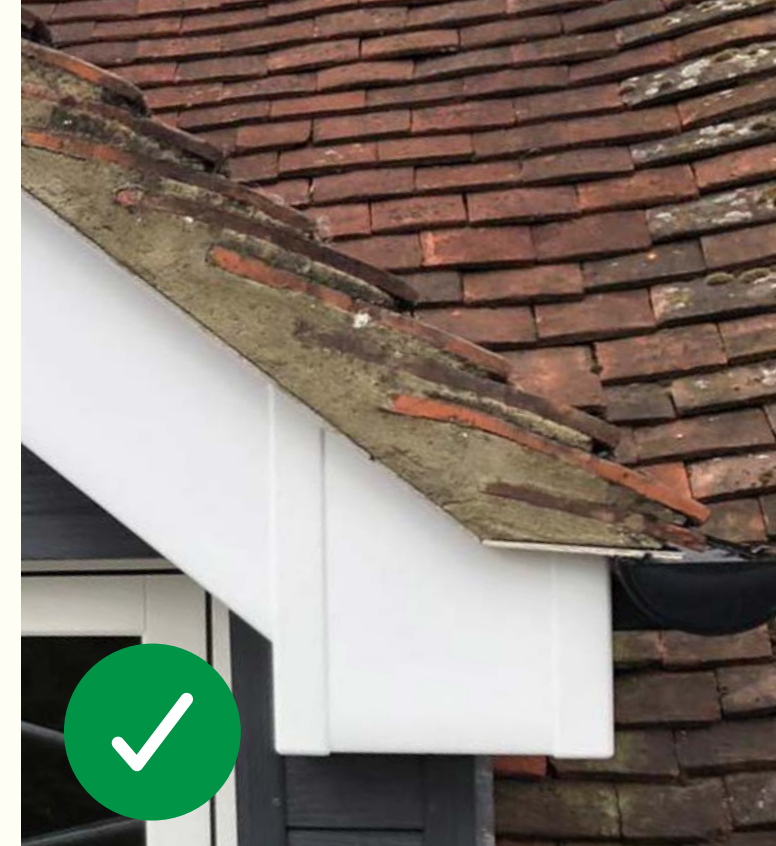

Each section was precisely aligned to recreate the home's traditional detailing while providing a maintenance-free, long-lasting finish.

Eaves protection system

This simple addition ensures your roofline performs perfectly for years — no sagging, no pooling, no leaks.

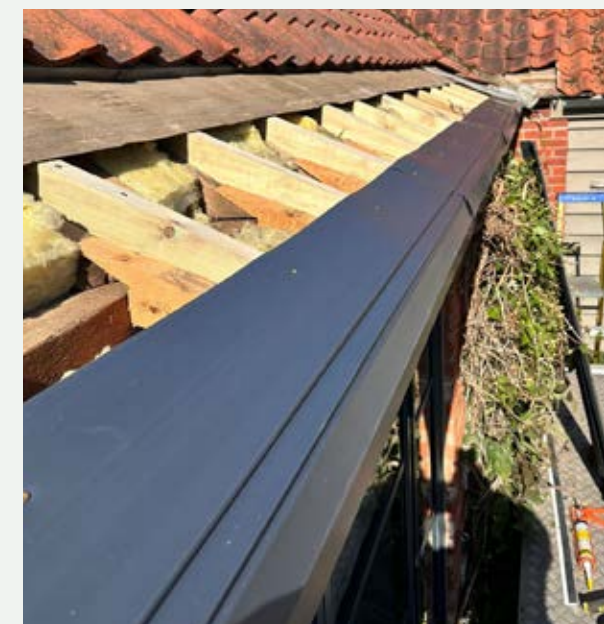
Eaves protection boards (also known as felt support trays) help prevent the roof felt from sagging at eaves level — a common issue that leads to water ponding and timber rot.

We install our eaves protection system as standard on all full replacement installations with pan tiled roofs.

The boards extend under the tiles and into the gutter, guiding rainwater safely away and ensuring your new roofline remains dry and structurally sound.

Note on Slate & Peg Tile Roofs

Eaves protection trays are not typically required on slate roofs or traditional peg tile roofs. These roof types are constructed with a soaker course at the eaves, which already performs the job of directing water safely into the guttering. Because this built-in system prevents felt sagging and ponding, additional eaves protection trays are unnecessary.

Gutter guard

A little prevention goes a long way — clean, clear guttering all year round.

Keep your guttering free from leaves, moss, and debris with our gutter guard system.

These durable mesh guards fit securely along the top of your gutters to prevent blockages and overflowing during heavy rain.

It's a simple, low-cost way to maintain free-flowing guttering and prevent future drainage issues, protecting your home from unnecessary water damage.

Note: Not available with half-round or ogee guttering.



Over-fascia ventilation

Cleverly designed airflow — inconspicuous from the outside, vital on the inside.

Good ventilation is essential for a healthy roof. Without it, condensation can build up in the roof space, leading to damp and mould.

Our over-fascia ventilation strips allow fresh air to circulate beneath the roof while remaining completely hidden from view — eliminating the need for unsightly soffit vents.

Discreet, effective, and compliant with modern building regulations, they keep your home dry and well-ventilated without affecting the clean lines of your new roofline.

Note: Not normally compatible with flat roofs.



Bird guard

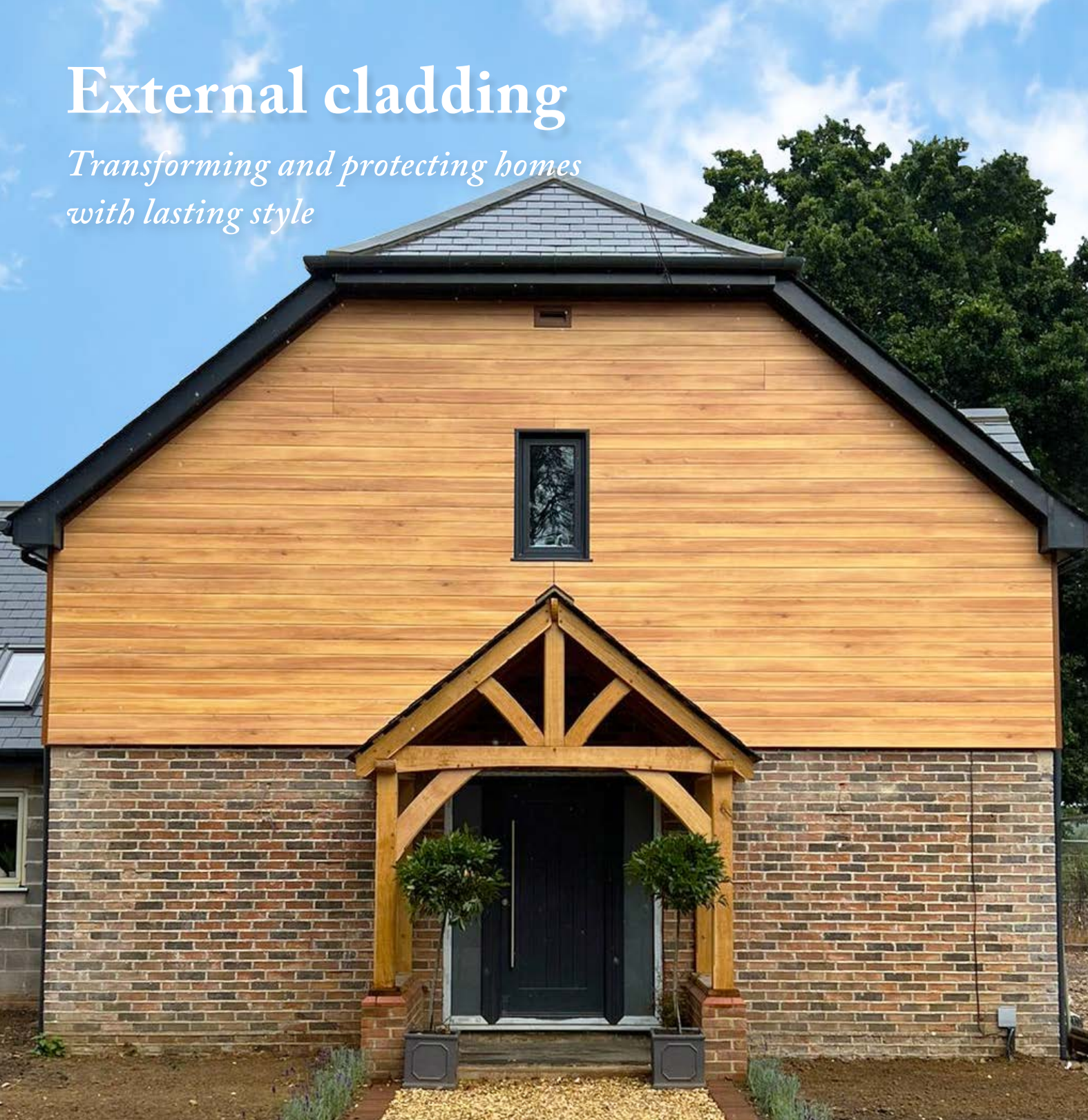
Stops pests, not airflow — the smart solution for corrugated rooflines.

Corrugated roof tiles naturally leave small gaps along the roof edge — perfect for ventilation, but unfortunately also an open invitation for small birds, insects, and vermin.

Our bird guard comb filler neatly seals these gaps while allowing the roof to breathe. It prevents nesting, mess, and gutter blockages — keeping your loft space clean and protected year-round.

Modern dormer and gable transformation with Hardie® Plank cladding in Light Mist — Clanfield, Hampshire



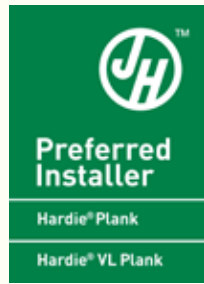
This property originally featured a tiled dormer exterior and old PVC cladding on the gable end.

We carefully removed all existing materials and installed Hardie® Plank fibre cement cladding in Light Mist, along with a complete fascia, soffit, and guttering replacement.

The result is a fresh, modern appearance with crisp lines and long-lasting durability.

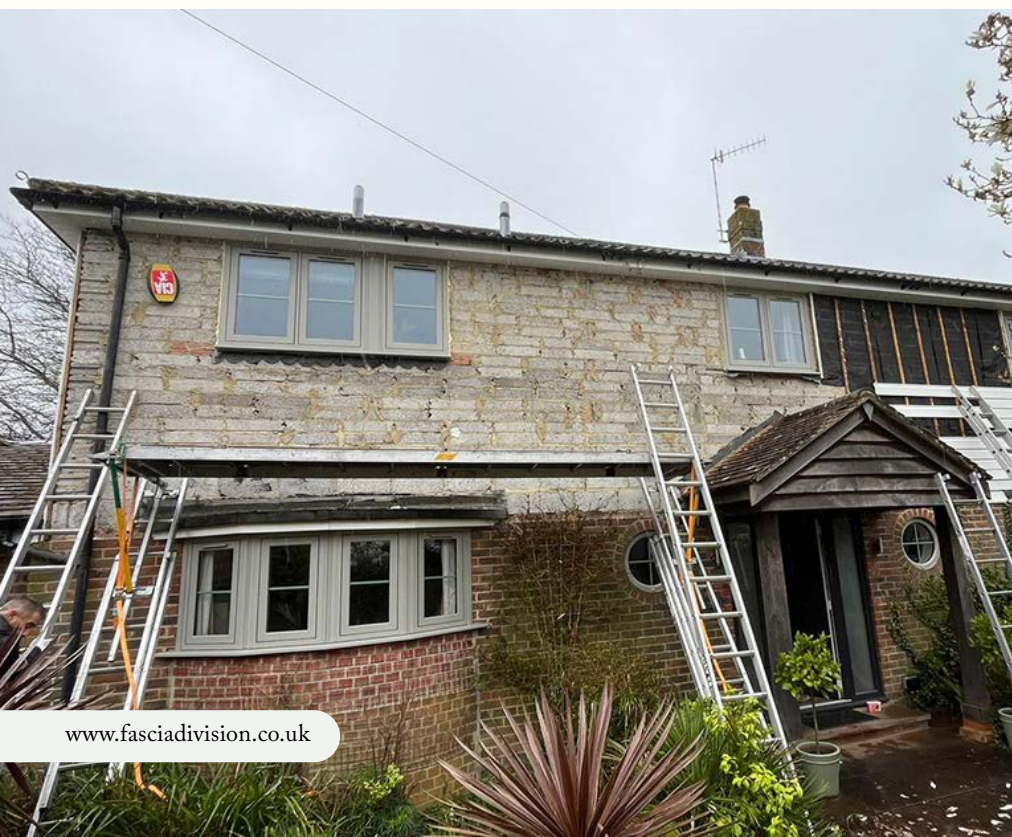

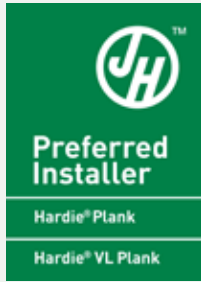


For this home, all the existing white PVC cladding around the upper level was removed and replaced with Hardie® Plank cladding in Cobble Stone.

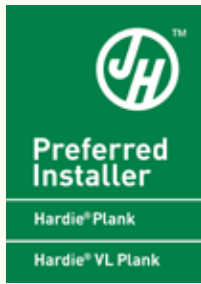

This elegant Edwardian home originally featured a tile-hung exterior section between two bay windows.

We removed all the old tiles and installed new breathable membrane, treated battens and ventilation strips before fitting Hardie® Plank weatherboard cladding in Evening Blue.

The result is a cleaner, more modern appearance that enhances insulation and protects the property from the elements — whilst retaining its period charm.

Note: We would normally install foil-backed insulation boards, however, this property already had a healthy and substantial amount of wool insulation which was kept.

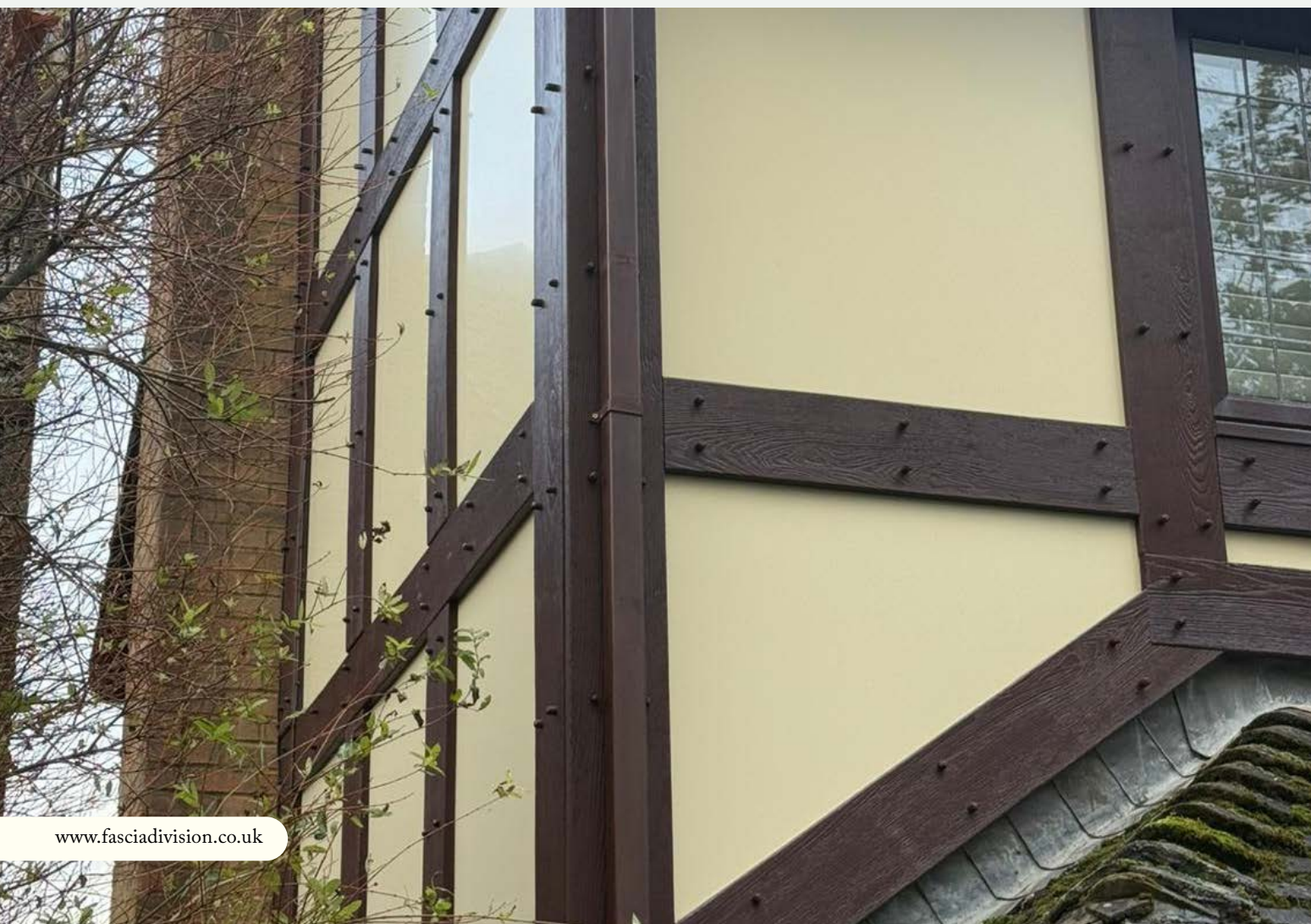

A striking transformation that restores timeless charm with a clean, low-maintenance finish.

This detached home in Swansea featured timber mock Tudor boards that had begun to rot and decay, leaving the exterior looking weathered and in need of constant repainting.

Our installation team removed all the old wooden beams and replaced them with authentic replica Tudor beams made from durable polyurethane, providing a long-lasting, maintenance-free solution that retains the traditional appearance without the upkeep.

To complete the transformation, we installed white composite render panels beneath the new beams — eliminating the need for painted render — along with new black uPVC fascia boards and matching black square guttering.

The result is a crisp, elegant façade that combines classic Tudor character with modern materials built to last.

Many homes built in the 1950s to 1970s feature concrete gutters (often known as Finlock gutters). While durable when first installed, over time these systems crack, absorb water, and leak, leading to damp walls, internal staining, and even structural damage. Traditional repairs like lining or coating rarely solve the problem permanently — they only delay the inevitable.

At The Fascia Division, we provide a complete concrete gutter removal and replacement service, transforming outdated systems into clean, efficient, and maintenance-free uPVC roofline solutions that protect your home for decades.

Our Replacement Process

Careful Removal: We cut all of the existing concrete gutter sections, ensuring no damage to the underlying structure.

Preparation: The exposed edge is sealed and stabilised with a treated timber backing.

Full Roofline Installation: New uPVC fascias, soffits, and guttering are installed to modern standards with hidden fixings and proper ventilation.

Finishing Touches: All joints are sealed, aligned, and finished for a clean, professional look.

This process completely eliminates the source of leaks, creates a rainwater flow outside of the walls, and dramatically improves the appearance of your home.



Verge replacement

Protecting the most exposed edge of your roof

The verge — where the roof tiles meet the gable end of your home — is one of the most exposed and vulnerable parts of any roofline.

Over time, mortar can crack, crumble, or wash away, leaving gaps that allow rainwater and wind to penetrate beneath the tiles.

If left untreated, this can cause damp, damaged roof timbers, or even internal staining and structural decay.

At The Fascia Division, verge replacement is one of our specialist services.

Our experienced installers carefully remove all loose or failing mortar, prepare the area, and rebuild the verge using high-quality materials and modern techniques — ensuring a clean, watertight finish that will stand the test of time.

Our Three-Stage Repair Process

Our Three-Stage Repair Process

- 1. Exposing the Damage**
We carefully remove the first few rows of tiles to uncover the underlying issue. This reveals any torn, sagging, or perished felt and highlights rotten battens that are no longer providing structural support.
- 2. Installing New Felt & Battens**
All damaged material is cut away. We then install new, high-performance breathable felt and replace the rotted battens with fresh treated timber, reinstating the roof's integrity and ensuring a clean, watertight run-off into the gutter.
- 3. Completing the Repair**
The tiles are refitted and aligned back into place. Once complete, the roofline is fully restored with a straight, secure edge designed to prevent future water ingress and prolong the life of the roof.

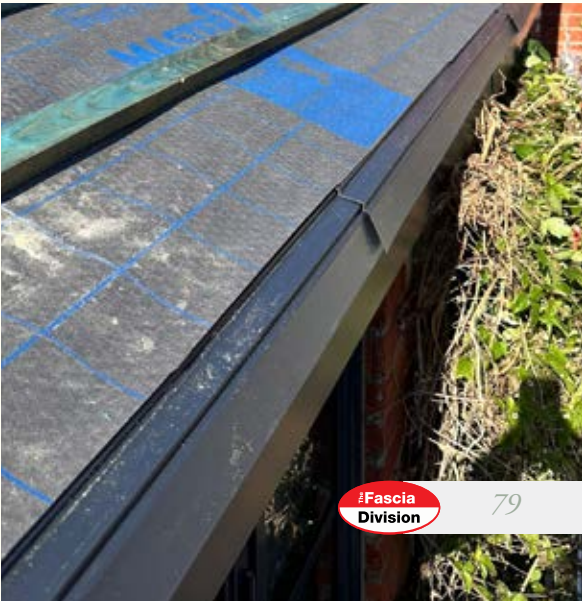
